

Eligibility

To be eligible for program housing, participant:

- Must be currently pregnant, regardless of trimester, -OR- within the postpartum period (up to 24 months after delivery)
- Must be 12 through 26 years old at the time of admission
- Must be actively enrolled in the Father Taaffe Homes program
- Must agree to follow community living rules and safety expectations
- Is willing to live in a communal or supervised housing environment
- Is willing to maintain a substance-free lifestyle during stay
- Has maintained 30 consecutive days of sobriety from drugs and alcohol prior to entry (exceptions may be made at the discretion of the Program Director)

Continued access to housing is linked to ongoing participation in FTH program services.

Exclusions

- Individuals outside the age range.
- Individuals not actively participating in the FTH program.
- Individuals who refuse or violate safety requirements.
- Individuals requiring a level of care beyond what the housing setting can safely provide.
